

**Managing Pests in corn and soy beans without breaking the bank and the environment:
Improved Integrated Pest Management approaches for corn and soy bean production**

Date: August 28, 29 and 30th (7pm)

Location: Clark County 4-H Fair grounds (9608 Highway 62, Charlestown)

Clark County Extension is putting together a three-part workshop to look at the common pests of corn and soy beans that exist today and how Integrated Pest Management (IPM) approaches can help reduce farm costs, increase farm profits and ensure land/environmental sustainability.

The workshop will take place each night on August 28, 29 and 30 from 7-9pm.

August 28th: The basic principles of IPM approaches

August 29th: Common Indiana pests of corn and soybeans and their impacts on production

August 30th: The application of IPM approaches to the common pest of corn and soy beans

The cost of all three classes is \$50 per participant. Registration and payment need to be made to Clark County Extension not later than August 23rd.
