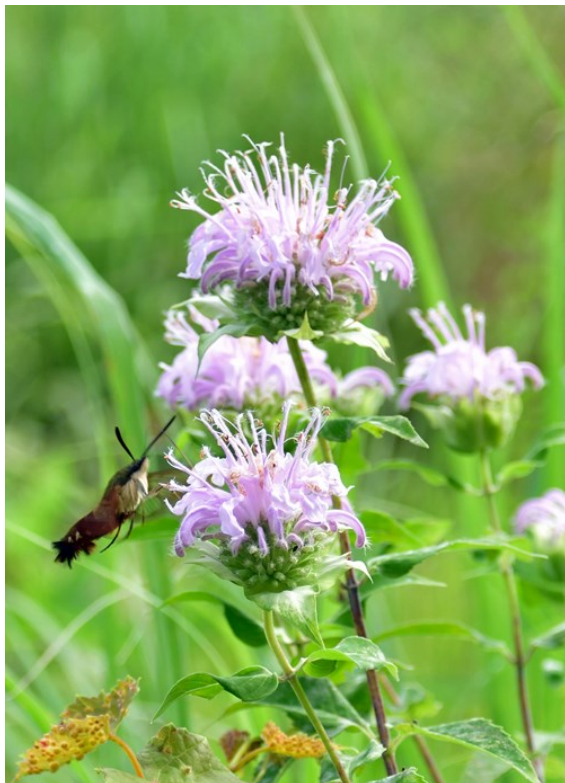


Native Plant & Pollinator Conservation
