The primary goal of the Shelby County 4-H Ambassador Program is to assist with advocating and promoting the Shelby County 4-H Program. Also to enhance your communication skills that will be utilized when advocating for our 4-H program. Ambassadors will strive to promote 4-H, encourage other youth members to become actively involved, take on leadership roles and teach at various events.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Enrolled as a Shelby County 4-H member.
- Enrolled in grades 8-12.
- Must be an active member of 4-H, involved with your club for at least one year prior to applying.

ROLE OF THE SHELBY COUNTY 4-H AMBASSADORS:

- Ambassadors will represent and promote the Shelby County 4-H Program at various events such as participating in school recruitment sessions with the 4-H educator and/or program assistant, during the Shelby County Fair and other 4-H events.
- Ambassadors will serve as role models for other youth members in the program. They are to behave in a professional, polite and helpful manner.
- Ambassadors may have the opportunity to teach and assist with events throughout Shelby County.

AMBASSADOR EXPECTATIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Serve as a positive role model to all 4-H youth.
- Assist with school recruitment 4-H promotions; share experiences and/or sample projects
- Assist with 4-H events at the Shelby County Fair and other miscellaneous county or state 4-H events as a Shelby County 4-H Ambassador.

With the primary goal of the Shelby County 4-H Ambassador Program to be advocating and promoting 4-H, the main event for ambassadors is school recruitment. This is where the 4-H Educator and the 4-H Program Assistant go into local elementary schools to discuss and promote 4-H. Ambassadors are to help participate in the presentation and share their 4-H experiences and/or sample projects, to get youth engaged and excited about “joining the club!”




