It really takes at least 12 people to operate the booth and not feel rushed. Remember senior citizens, grandparents, Jr. Leaders, etc. are all welcome to assist with your shift.

The day shift should be ready to serve at 7 AM. This would mean coming in at 6:30 AM and three volunteers arriving at 6 AM to get sausage ready, coffee will be on timers.
