## How do I join?

### When can I start 4-H?

4-H is open to youth in grades 3 – 12.

Mini 4-H is offered for youth in grades Kindergarten - 2.

### How much does it cost?

The yearly 4-H program fee is \$20 per 4-H member and \$5 for Mini 4-H members. Fee waiver options are available.
