Wondering what is in the State 4-H Scholarship packet?

How about two FREE national 4-H trips and
scholarship money for college!

Current Sophomores through Seniors are eligible for:

- National 4-H Conference in Washington, D.C.
 - Application is due December 1st, 2019 for the 2020 Spring Trip
- National 4-H Congress in Atlanta, Georgia for the 2020 Fall Trip
- Indiana 4-H Accomplishment Resume Scholarship – a minimum of 33 winners statewide receive a scholarship (\$1000 - \$2,000) and recognition at the Indiana 4-H Congress in October 2020 at the Indiana State Fairgrounds

Seniors only are also eligible for the Indiana 4-H Foundation Scholarship – more than 200 of these scholarships are awarded throughout Indiana each year.

With the exception of the National 4-H Conference, applications are due to the County Extension Office no later than January 25th, 2020.

While Sophomores through Seniors are eligible, this workshop is for ALL high school 4-H members so that you can learn more and start early. The information you gather for this application will be helpful when you are going through the college application process.
