

SILVERNOTES EXTENSION HOMEMAKERS SCHOLARSHIP TERMS

The Hamilton County Silvernotes Extension Homemakers will award **one (1) \$500.00** scholarship to a Hamilton County graduating senior who plans to major or minor in music.

The scholarship will be given on the following basis.

1. To be eligible you must:
 - a. Be a high school senior entering college, majoring or minoring in Music.
 - b. Have maintained a C average or greater.
2. The scholarship is a one-time award.
3. Complete and submit the attached application.
4. Complete and submit a written essay on the importance of music in your life. Essay should be no more than two (2) single spaced typed pages.
5. Obtain a sealed reference letter from your music director or school counselor. Reference letter should include information on financial need, music ability, and personal character.
6. Applications are due to the Silvernotes Extension Homemakers Club **no later than March 1**. Recipients will be notified no later than May 1.
7. A scholarship committee of the Silvernotes Extension Homemakers Club will review the applications. In judging, the following points will be considered:
 - a. Applicant's chosen field of study
 - b. Financial Need
 - c. School & community activities
 - d. Character
 - e. Personality
8. The committee may elect to award additional scholarships if funds are available.
