

1. Exhibit one built Lego Scene—not from a kit
 - (a) Entire exhibit shall not exceed 12” long by 12” wide by 12” high.
 - (b) Exhibit shall not have any moving parts. See Rule #9 under “General Rules”.
 - (c) Motorized parts are not permitted at this level.
 - (d) May contain:
 1. Up to 1 structure
 2. Up to 8 people and/or animals
 3. Up to 1 wheeled object

Level B (Grades 5-6):

1. Exhibit one built Lego Scene—not from a kit
 - (a) Entire exhibit shall not exceed 18” long by 18” wide by 18” high, including fully extended parts.
 - (b) Exhibit may have moving parts; however it is not required.
 - (c) Motorized parts are not permitted at this level.
 - (d) May contain:
 1. Up to 2 structures
 2. Up to 12 people and/or animals
 3. Up to 2 wheeled objects

Level C (Grades 7-9):

1. Exhibit two related built Lego Scenes—not from a kit
 - (a) Entire exhibit shall not exceed 18” long by 18” wide by 24” high, including fully extended parts.
 - (b) Exhibit must include at least one part. In one of the scenes.
 - (c) Motorized parts are not permitted at this level.
 - (d) May contain:
 1. Up to 4 structures
 2. Up to 16 people and/or animals
 3. Up to 4 wheeled objects

Level D (Grades 10-12):

1. Exhibit three related built Lego Scenes—not from a kit
 - (a) Entire exhibit shall not exceed 24” long by 24” wide by 36” high, including fully extended parts.
 - (b) Exhibit must include at least one moveable or motorized parts.
 - (c) Electric lights may be used at this level.
 - (d) May contain:
 1. Up to 6 structures
 2. Up to 20 people and/or animals

Up to 6 wheeled objects

Requirement for judging:

- If multiple pieces make up the exhibit, a photograph of the complete exhibit should be attached to the exhibit so the total exhibit can properly be displayed. For safety purposes any craft exhibit that resembles a sword, knife, or look-a-like weapon will be judged but will not be displayed.
- Miscellaneous Crafts require craft card(s) for exhibit.

Model Craft

Judging - Thursday, July 2, at 6:00pm at the Fairgrounds; Shrine Building.

Will be considered for State Fair with the Any Other Crafts Category

Requirement for judging:

- If multiple pieces make up the exhibit, a photograph of the complete exhibit should be attached to the exhibit so the total exhibit can properly be displayed. For safety purposes any craft exhibit that resembles a sword, knife, or look-a-like weapon will be judged but will not be displayed.
- Exhibits must be a small scale replica and meet the following criteria:
 - Must be of injected styrene plastics
 - At least 25% of the exhibit must be painted
 - Wood, paper, clay, die-cast, or snap together models are not permitted
 - Screws are not permitted
 - Pre-painted or pre-decaled factory models are not permitted
 - Legos are not considered models and are to be exhibited as Any Other Craft
- If the model is being built from a kit, include a copy of the instructions with the craft information card.

Level A: Exhibits should be mounted on a piece of Styrofoam that extends no more than 1” on all sides of the model and that is approximately 1” thick.

Grade 3: Assemble a 1/24th or 1/25th scale plastic model car or truck kit. No die cast – pre-painted models. “Snap together” kits are NOT to be used. Use only the parts sold and furnished with the stock kit. Current store merchandising may mean you’ll have to buy a 3 in 1 or 2 in 1 kit. Assemble ONLY the stock version of the kit for 4-H exhibits. Windows are to be installed. Do not paint or add any decals to your model.

Grade 4: Assemble a 1/24th or 1/25th scale plastic model car or truck. “Snap together” kits are NOT to be used. Exhibit ONLY the stock version of the kit. Windows are to be installed. DO NOT paint the model, but DO apply decals.

Level B: Exhibits should be mounted on a piece of Styrofoam that extends no more than 1” on all sides of the model and that is approximately 1” thick.

Grade 5 Assemble a 1/24th or 1/25th scale plastic model car or truck. “Snap together” kits are NOT to be used.
