



Wearable Art

Judging - Tuesday, June 30, at 9am at the Extension Office; Main Hall.

Will be considered for State Fair with the Any Other Crafts Category

Wearable Art involves making an article(s) of clothing and/or accessories that can be worn that is creatively decorated. An accessory includes such items as a tote bag, hat, shoes, belt, hair accessory, jewelry (only if part of the ensemble), etc.

Project Requirements:

1. All project participants must bring the craft skills card with their exhibit.
2. Bring a copy of the pattern or instruction sheet to judging.
3. Exhibits should show a greater degree of difficulty each year.
4. Cross-stitching does not fit in this category. It is considered a needlecraft.

Level A – Grades 3-4

1. A t-shirt or chef's apron that has been decorated using one of the following techniques:
 - a. Tie-dye
 - b. Sponge painting
 - c. Full color iron-on transfer (maximum 9" x 9")

*One or two colors of paint may be used to enhance your article.

Level B – Grades 5-6

1. A vest, or t-shirt, or sweatshirt that has been decorated using one of the following techniques:
 - a. Color paint
 - b. Fusible appliqué (paint finished or machine finished)
 - c. Glue on embellishments

*No more than 3 separate appliquéd areas per article. One to two colors of paint may be used to enhance your article.

Level C – Grades 7 -9

1. A vest or t-shirt or sweatshirt or jacket AND one accessory (tote bag, or pair of shoes or hat) that has been decorated using one of the following techniques:
 - a. Fusible appliqué (paint finished or machine finished)
 - b. Fabric painting with iron-on transfer
 - c. Color paint (5 or more colors)
 - d. Jeweled design (5 or more colors or styles of jewels)Embellish as desired!

Level D – Grades 10-12

1. An ensemble of 3 or more articles (including decorated accessories). NO KITS. Jewelry may only be included if it is part of the ensemble. You may use an original design or variation of a pattern or patterns. You may use specialty threads or embellishments.
