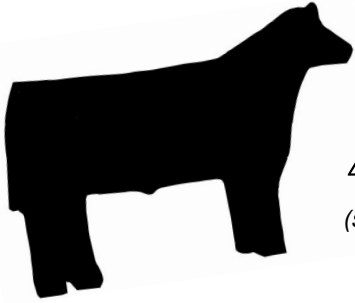

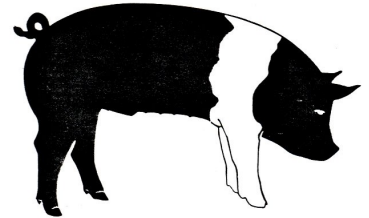

Beef, Swine, Sheep and Goats General Show Rules

1. All species will have showmanship available and will be grouped by age of the exhibitor as of Show Day.
2. Animals must be free of warts, ringworm, and other communicable diseases. Out of state animals must be accompanied by CVI within 30 days of show.
3. No artificial filling, injections or artificial hair of any kind will be permitted.
4. Four head or more animals needed for a breeding division. Otherwise will show in all other breeds class.
5. Market animals will be shown by weight.
6. All committee decisions are final.
7. No generators allowed in barns.
8. Cash premiums and ribbons will be awarded at the time of show.
9. All participants must clean up their stall areas and pens before leaving the grounds following these shows.
10. All participants must present a valid premise ID at check in. Beef animals must have an 840 approved Visual or RFID Tag in place. Swine animals must have RFID tag and/or ear notch. Sheep and goats must have at least flock or scrapie tag.
- 11. No bedding allowed in parking lots or roadways. Bedding must be contained to the barns and/or trailers.**
12. Beef and swine animals MUST be in their specific barns and/or own trailers near the barns. Due to biosecurity issues, animals may not go in other animal barns except sheep and goats in the cattle barn only.

Additional Swine Rules

1. Registration papers required to be in Purebred Breeding Class.
2. Those without papers will show in Crossbred Class.
3. Gilts may be double entered if paying fees for both market and breeding.

Additional Beef Rules

1. Registered heifer classes will be determined by breed and age. Registered heifers must have registration papers and readable tattoo. All others show as commercial heifers in classes by weight.
2. Market Beef classes will be determined by weight. Show committee will determine weight breaks.
3. No horned animals allowed over 6 months of age.
4. Market heifers may be double entered if paying fees for both market and breeding.

Additional Sheep and Goat Rules

1. Breeding ewe lambs and yearling ewes, show for Champion and Reserve Champion by breed. Breed Champions, AOB Champions, and Crossbred Champions will compete for overall Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Breeding Ewe.
2. Goats will be sub-divided in to 2 divisions – Meat and Pygmy All divisions will be considered for Grand Champion Goat. This means only one set of banners will be given.
3. Market lambs (ewes and wethers) will be shown by weight only, not by breed.
4. Market animals 9 months or less, No yearlings.
5. Breeding does will be shown by age.
6. Approximately 10 head per class.
