## **Purdue Extension to Host Private Applicator Recertification Program (PARP) February 25**

Purdue Extension will host a Private Applicator Recertification Program (PARP) February 25 at the Whitley County 4-H Center. Check-in will begin at 1:30 p.m. and the program will run from 2:00 – 4:00 p.m. Program topics include managing herbicide-resistant weeds, an update on crop diseases and fungicide use, and a dicamba update. (Note that the dicamba update is for information only – it does not qualify as the mandatory annual training from product manufacturers.)

This program will count toward your pesticide or fertilizer private applicator license with the standard \$10 fee.

Additional opportunities for PARP credit will be available at the NEPAC field day Aug. 20, and tentatively at an evening program in December. Programs are also available in the region. Keep abreast of upcoming programs at:
