Application due by May 15th

1. A minimum of one \$250.00 scholarship (non-renewable) will be awarded. Selection will be made by the Randolph Riders Horse and Pony Committee.
2. For any post-secondary or trade school. Does not have to be in Indiana
3. Must be a current member of Randolph Riders 4-H Club.
4. Must be a Randolph Rider 4-H member for the past 3 years and shown in the 4-H Horse and Pony for at least 5 years.
5. Complete the Randolph Riders Horse and Pony Scholarship Application form.
6. Application due in the Randolph County Extension Office, 1885 S U.S. Hwy 27, Winchester, IN 47394, by May 15th.
7. Winners will be announced at the 4-H Fair in July after the Horse and Pony senior ride.
8. Money will be awarded when the student or parent presents a paid tuition receipt or a copy of grade card from college or university, or trade school.
9. Previous winners are not eligible to reapply.
