For County Fair

Beef and Dairy Beef Steers	840-RFID Tag
Commercial and Market Heifers and Dairy Feeder	840-RFID Tag
Beef, Registered Heifers	840-RFID tag and Tattoo
Dairy Cattle	840-RFID tag and animal's registered name and registration number (or dam's registration number)
Dairy Goat Females, Registered	Breed Registry Tattoo
Wethers	5-digit County Tag or Tattoo
Meat Goat Wethers	Official Scrapie identification tag, with US shield or Official Scrapie tattoo or a form of permanent identification
Boer Goat Females, Registered	Breed Registry Tattoo
Market Goat Does (Wether Dams)	Official Scrapie identification tag, with US shield or Official Scrapie tattoo or registration tattoo (if none county can assign 840 tag)
Pygmy Goats Registered	Breed Registry Tattoo or Microchip that Matches Registration Papers
Unregistered	Official USDA Scrapie Tag or Official Scrapie Tattoo if none county can assign 840 tag)
Horses and Pony	2 colored photos(face and all 4 feet)
Llama and Alpaca	2 colored photos(face and all 4 feet)
Sheep Market Lambs	Official Scrapie identification tag, with US shield or Official Scrapie tattoo or a form of permanent identification
Commercial Ewes	Official Scrapie identification tag, with US shield or Official Scrapie tattoo or
Registered Ewes	ID that matches registration Papers
Swine	Ear Notch – 840 RFID tag (needed for animals that are not registered with a purebred swine association)
