Fair Entry.....

ALL exhibit building projects will be judged virtually this year. What does this mean? For each project that you are entering into Fair Entry, you will need to upload pictures. These pictures are required and you will not be able to submit your entry until you have completed this step. A list of what type of pictures you will need to have by project will be posted on the county website as well as club facebook pages. Picture files will need to be one of the following; .JPG, .PNG, .GIF, .TIF. For projects with notebooks, or other supporting documents they will need to be either a .PDF, Word or Powerpoint file. **If you need help getting your documents into one of these type formats, please contact the office and Sylvia & Lisa will be happy to help you.**

APPROVED Animal Grooming Assistance Program (Applications due by July 15, 2020)

This year in addition to completing the application, participants must complete the online Animal Ethics modules every two years. If applicants completed the training modules in 2019 they do not have to complete them in 2020.

This will be required for those wishing to assist 4-H members with livestock at the Indiana State Fair. Participants will receive a letter of confirmation once they have completed the program.

The entire notebook or presentation is to be included in a single electronic file using PDF, Word, or Power Point.

Take the photo in a well-lit area. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible.

All guidelines (includes Titles, dimensions, etc.) from the handbook are to be followed for Virtual Judging

Abraham Lincoln	Poster or Display	Be sure the entire poster/Display is visible in the photo. Supporting paperwork. Picture from the side (if not a poster).
Achievement Resume	Notebook	Jr. Level - Resume, Supporting Pictures, Record of Achievement Pages Sr. Level – Cover Letter, Resume, Supporting Pictures, Record of Achievement pages
Aerospace	Rocket or Poster	Be sure the entire poster or rocket is visible in the photo.
Alfalfa	Flake of Hay	Picture of entire Flake, Close up Picture of the side (within 6 inches), Record sheets (Pages should be in a single file using PDF, Word, Power Point).
Americana	Display	Be sure the entire Display is visible in the photo. Pages from your notebook.
Aquatic Science	Poster or Display	Be sure the entire poster/display is visible in the photo.
Arts and Crafts:	Fine Art, Needle Craft, Model Craft, or Basic Craft	Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. The craft information card will be a second file upload.
BBQ	Poster	Be sure the entire poster is visible in the photo. Completed BBQ Journal Sheet
Beekeeping	Poster, Honey Jar, Honey Comb Box, Other Exhibit	Be sure the entire poster or jar is visible in the photo. The judge should also be able to see the honey's clarity and any dirt or debris that may be dispersed throughout the honey.
Beekeeping	Notebook or Presentation	The entire notebook or presentation is to be included in a single electronic file using PDF, Word, Power Point, or Excel format.
Bicycle	Poster	Be sure the entire poster is visible in the photo.
Cake Decorating	Cake	Be sure the entire cake, showing the top and side, is visible in the photo. The skills card will be a second file upload.
Cat Poster	Poster	Be sure the entire poster is visible in the photo.
Child Development	Display or Poster	Be sure the entire poster is visible in the photo. The activity card will be a second file upload.

Create-with-A-Mix	Baked Item	Picture of your finished project (photo must include tops & bottoms of project (i.e. cookies must exhibit 6 cookies so flip 3 of them over so we can see the bottom side of them)) Picture of your recipe card with ingredients added underlined Picture of your dated recipes cards of other things you have tried.
Creative Wrap	Wrapped item	Be sure the entire poster is visible in the photo. Picture of the information card.
Creative Writing	Written Document	Upload as a word or PDF document your entire project.
Cupcake Decorating	Cupcakes	Picture of your entire cupcake display from a TOP view. Up close pictures of 2 different cupcakes.
Electric	Circuit Board	The bulb is to be lit. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. Upload a second photo showing at least one soldered connection. Upload your "What have I done or learned" as a single document in PDF or Word format.
Electric	Magnetic Flashlight	Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. Upload a second photo showing at least one soldered or wired connection.
Electric	Extension Cord, Shop Light, or Lamp	Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. Upload a second photo showing a plug-in end uncapped so the wiring connections is visible.
Electric	Other Exhibits	Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. Upload a second photo showing at least one wiring connection.
Electric	Electronic Exhibits	Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. Upload a second photo showing the circuit board and soldering. Upload a copy of the schematics.
Electric	Notebook	The entire notebook or presentation is to be included in a single electronic file using PDF, Word, Power Point, or Excel format.
Entomology	Poster or Collection Box	The plexiglass covering will likely need removed to eliminate glare. Be sure the entire poster or collection box is visible in the photo. One, two or three photos will be uploaded based on grade level exhibit requirements.

Farm Scene	Photo	Two (2) pictures of your entire project from opposite corners,

Foods, Baked	Cookies	Three baked cookies are to be plated; two right-side up and the third upside-down and broken in half showing the inside and bottom. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. The recipe card will be a second upload.
Foods, Baked	Muffins	Three unlined muffins are to be plated; two right-side up and the third broken in half showing the inside and bottom. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. The recipe card will be a second upload.
Foods, Baked	Cake	Plate the cake for display and remove one slice from the edge to the center. On a small dessert type plate place the removed slice upside down showing the bottom. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. The recipe card will be a second upload.
Foods, Baked	No-Yeast Pretzels or No-Yeast Biscuits	Three baked pretzels or biscuits are to be plated; two right-side up and the third upside-down and broken in half showing the inside and bottom. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. The recipe card will be a second upload.
Foods, Baked	Yeast Bread Sticks or Rolls	Three baked bread sticks or rolls are to be plated; two right-side up and the third upside-down and broken in half showing the inside and bottom. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. The recipe card will be a second upload.
Foods, Baked	Yeast Bread Loaf	Slice the loaf of bread in half at its middle plating one half right-side up and the other half upside-down showing its middle and bottom crust. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. The recipe card will be a second upload.
Foods, Baked	Invented Healthy Snack	Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. The recipe card will be a second upload. A third upload will be the entire notebook or presentation is to be included in a single electronic file using PDF, Word, Power Point, or Excel format.
Foods, Baked	Fruit Pie	Remove one slice of pie. On a small dessert type plate place the removed slice upside down showing the bottom crust. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. The recipe card will be a second upload.
Foods, Baked	Low Fat-Reduced Sugar Product or Special Dietary Product	Remove a portion of the product and place it upside down on a dessert type plate showing the bottom. Take the photo showing the entire dish and plated portion in a well-lit area. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. The recipe card will be a second upload. A third upload will be the entire notebook or presentation is to be included in a single electronic file using PDF, Word, Power Point, or Excel format.
Foods, Preserved	Frozen Baked Cookies, Frozen Berries, Frozen Pizza, Frozen Vegetables, Freezer Jam, or Frozen Entrée	Take a photo of the entire packaged exhibit showing the label. If the exhibit is covered in aluminum foil or non-see-through plastic wrap, remove a corner of that covering so the product is visible. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. The recipe card will be a second upload.

Foods, Preserved	Canned Tomato Product, Canned Pickle Product, Pressure Canned Product, or Cooked Jam/Reduced-Sugar Fruit Spread	Take a photo of the canned product showing the label. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. The recipe card will be a second upload.
Forestry	Poster	Be sure the entire poster is visible in the photo.
Forestry	Notebook	The entire notebook or presentation is to be included in a single electronic file using PDF, Word, Power Point, or Excel format.
Garden	Educational Exhibit Poster	Be sure the entire poster is visible in the photo.

International	Poster or Display	Be sure the entire poster or exhibit display is visible in one photo. The entire notebook or presentation is to be included in a single electronic file using PDF, Word, Power Point.

Make sure the recording area is well-lit with minimal background noises. Be sure to dress as if you were presenting live in front of the judge and audience. Make sure the recording area is well-lit with minimal background noises. Be sure to dress as if you were presenting live in front of the judge and audience. The recording settings should be set to only visible with a link. You will provide that link when submitting entry. The entire handout packet is to be included in a single electronic file using PDF, Word, Power Point, or Excel format as a second file upload.
Public Speaking	Video	Create a video according to exhibit requirements and upload it to YouTube or another video hosting site. Recording on a phone or similar device will work. Make sure the recording area is well-lit with minimal background noises. Be sure to dress as if you were presenting live in front of the judge and audience. The recording settings should be set to only visible with a link. You will provide that link when submitting entry.
Pumpkin	Pumpkin	Be sure the entire pumpkin is visible in the photo. Picture of your pumpkin on a scales (weight verification)
Reading	Poster or Display	Be sure the entire poster/display is visible in the photo. Additional pictures can be uploaded as .JPG, .PNG, .TIF, .GIF file

Recycling	Image, notebook, document	Upload an image AND a notebook or document of the process of your project PDF, WORD, or Powerpoint. Pictures of your Solid Waste Checklist and Notecard.
Scarecrow	Display	Pictures of your scarecrow from the Front & Back. Copy of your Scarecrow's story.
Scrapbooking	Scrapbook	Picture of the front of your Scrapbook, Upload all 10 pages to be judge, in its entirety, in a single electronic file using PDF, Word, or Power Point.
Sewing	Wearable	Take a photo of the front of the article showing its finished side. Take a second photo of the article turned inside out showing the article's back side, seams, hooks and zipper. Take a third photo of the zipper, hooks or fasteners (only one photo if more than one fastener). Be sure the article has been pressed and photos are taken in a well-lit area with the article laying flat, like on a bed. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire article is visible in the photo. The skills card will be uploaded as a fourth file.
Sewing	Non-Wearable Article	Take a photo of the front of the article showing its finished side. Take a second photo of the back of the article. Take a third photo of a sewn seam, the zipper, hooks or fasteners (only one photo if more than one fastener). Be sure the article has been pressed, if possible, and photos are taken in a well-lit area with the article displayed for its intended use. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire article is visible in the photo. The skills card will be uploaded as a fourth file.
Sewing	Construction Technique or Sewing Machine Survey	The entire notebook or presentation is to be included in a single electronic file using PDF, Word, Power Point, or Excel format.
Shooting Sports Education	Poster or Display	Be sure the entire poster or display is visible in the photo.
