Dear 4-H Member,


Every 4-H member in the **Sewing Wearable** category is invited to participate in the county **Fashion Revue** judging.

Fashion Revue gives 4-H'ers a chance to wear and display their outfits. The focus of Fashion Revue is on modeling, garment fit and appearance, and accessorizing.

The date of the private judging for Hamilton County 4-H Fashion Revue is **TUESDAY, JULY 7, 2020** in the evening. Judging will be held in Exhibition Center Hall C at the Hamilton County 4-H Fairgrounds in Noblesville (2003 Pleasant Street). Please make **SPECIAL** note of the following:

1. This year, in order to participate in Fashion Revue judging, **you MUST pre-register by WEDNESDAY, JULY 1** by submitting this Google form <https://bit.ly/Fashionrevuregistration>. You will NOT be allowed to participate if you do not pre-register by July 1.
2. A specific arrival time will be assigned to each 4-H'er as soon as possible after July 1 and will be sent via email.
3. Please give yourself plenty of time to arrive at the 4-H Fairgrounds so that you are ready to check in on-site with a volunteer at your designated arrival time.
4. Check-in and line-up will be held in the hallway closest to the Extension Office.
5. This year, you should arrive dressed and ready in your outfit. Judges will be made aware of this so as not to mark down for wrinkles in garments. (The only exception to this is if you are modeling multiple outfits. In this case, you may change in the restroom off the hallway closest to the Office.)
6. You are allowed **ONLY** one adult to accompany you to the judging.
7. You and your accompanying adult must wear face coverings.
8. A volunteer will take your photograph when it is your turn to enter Hall C.
9. Your accompanying adult will be allowed to enter Hall C with you and take photos/video of you during your individual judging time.
10. You and your accompanying adult will exit Hall C and the building immediately following your individual judging time. (Again, the only exception to this is if you are modeling multiple outfits.)
11. In the interest of health and safety, there will NOT be a public Fashion Revue this year. The photographs taken during judging and the Fashion Revue judging results will be displayed near the Sewing project exhibit area during the 4-H Exhibit.
12. Please follow the project guidelines for Sewing and Fashion Revue in the 4-H Handbook requirements.
