We thank everyone who picked up your tags for your animals in May.

All Morgan County 4-H Swine must also have a **hair sample for exhibition into the Extension Office by July 1.**

All swine shown at the Morgan County 4-H show must have a radio frequency identification tag (RFID tag), according to the Board of Animal Health regulations and be ear notched.

You must register each pig **online** at <https://in.4honline.com> with tag numbers by **July 1. Have your Premise I.D. number and tag information for each animal per child handy.**

Exhibitors must have a current Youth for the Quality Care of Animals (YQCA) certification.

YQCA—Please Read!

1. If you are exhibiting a meat or dairy animal at the **state fair**, you are required to complete the YQCA training, either online or in person at www.yqca.org.
2. If you are exhibiting a meat or dairy animal at the county fair only, there is an online option called Animal Ethics that is free (2020 only). There are four modules and a quiz here: <https://extension.purdue.edu/4h/Pages/Online-Animal-Ethics-Program.aspx> You must complete all four modules and the quiz in order to receive credit for a substitute YQCA certification. Again, this is for the county fair only. The shorter link for this training is www.bit.ly/4hcrt
When you complete the Animal Ethics modules it is important you complete the survey link for credit: https://purdue.ca1.qualtrics.com/jfe/form/SV_2aAOaEAK0BEGoRv
3. Remember—you need to complete either YQCA or the Animal Ethics program in order to exhibit a meat or dairy animal at the county fair.

Practice wearing a face covering (mask, bandana or face shield) around your animals. Exhibitors of 4-H Swine are required to wear a face covering while in the show arena, since swine don't practice social distancing.

Only family members of 4-H members exhibiting at the fair are to attend. They should bring their own lawn chairs to sit in. Once the child's class is over, you should return to the barn.

Animals must be shown live or virtual to be sold to buyer.

If we are not in Stage 5 by fair time, EVERYTHING will be shown virtually.

Livestock auction is a Sale and the flyers will be available to you and the buyers after the 4th of July.
