2020 Exceptions for virtual projects:

- All Projects:** Providing a reference list is not required.
- Posters:** Sleeves and hard backing are not required as exhibits will not be displayed and plastic sleeves will cause a glare when photographing.
- Fine Arts:** Having exhibits suitable for hanging is not required as exhibits will not be displayed at a fair for public viewing.
- Photography Salon Prints:** Photos may be uploaded directly to Fair Entry. Mounting on a salon board is optional since the exhibit will not be displayed for public viewing.
- Display boxes:** In order to improve quality and reduce glare, remove covers on display boxes for pictures.

Where do I find my project in Fair Entry?

When you log into faireentry.com you will see a grid for the fair, under the department column there are several categories, some are statewide departments and some are county only departments. To help you find your projects, we have listed the appropriate department in the chart on the following pages.

Livestock members who are completing the project by submitting their worksheet must upload a copy of their finished worksheet into the appropriate category in Fair Entry. Livestock poster images should also be uploaded into Fair Entry. All livestock exhibits to be judged will have videos or pictures (rabbits and poultry) uploaded and judged through "Virtual Cattle Battle" and these instructions will be sent out as soon as they are available.

Aerospace <i>State Static Projects</i>	Rocket or Poster Image	Take the photo in a well-lit area. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire poster or rocket is visible in the photo.
Arts and Crafts <i>County Only Static Projects</i>	Craft Image	Take the photo in a well-lit area. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. The craft information card will be a second file upload.
Baskets <i>County Only Static Projects</i>	Basket Image	Take the photo in a well-lit area. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. Child Development <i>State Static Projects</i>	Display or Poster Images or Notebook	Take the photo in a well-lit area. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire poster is visible in the photo. The activity card will be a second file upload. The entire notebook or presentation is to be included in a single electronic file using PDF, Word, Power Point, or Excel format.
Collections <i>County Only Static Projects</i>	Poster, Notebook or Image of collection	Take the photo in a well-lit area. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. The Collections Record will be a second file upload. If your collection is displayed in a notebook, include the entire notebook in a single electronic file using PDF, Word, Power Point, or Excel format.
Computer <i>State Static Projects</i>	Notebook	The entire notebook or presentation is to be included in a single electronic file using PDF, Word, Power Point, or Excel format.
Consumer Clothing <i>State Static Projects</i>	Image and Notebook	Upload a photo of the purchased outfit. Take the photo in a well-lit area. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. The entire notebook or presentation is to be included in a single electronic file using PDF, Word, Power Point, or Excel format.
Creative Writing <i>County Only Static Projects</i>	Notebook	The entire notebook or presentation is to be included in a single electronic file using PDF, Word, Power Point, or Excel format.
Crops <i>County Only Static Projects</i>	Crops Image	Take the photo in a well-lit area. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. The exhibit information card will be a second file upload.
Dogs <i>State Static Projects</i>	Dog Poster Image	Create a poster on something that you've learned in the dog project, following the 4-H poster requirements. Take the photo in a well-lit area. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire poster is visible in the photo.
Electric I <i>State Static Projects</i>	Circuit Board Images (Division I)	Take the photo in a well-lit area. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. The bulb is to be lit. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. Upload a second photo showing at least one soldered connection. Upload your "What have I done or learned" as a single document in PDF or Word format.

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Electric II <i>State Static Projects</i>	Magnetic Flashlight Images (Division II)	Take the photo in a well-lit area. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. Upload a second photo showing at least one soldered or wired connection.
Electric III <i>State Static Projects</i>	Extension Cord, Shop Light, or Lamp Images (Division III)	Take the photo in a well-lit area. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. Upload a second photo showing a plug-in end uncapped so the wiring connections is visible.
Electric IV & Up <i>State Static Projects</i>	Other Exhibits Images	Take the photo in a well-lit area. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. Upload a second photo showing at least one wiring connection.
Electric IV & Up <i>State Static Projects</i>	Electronic Exhibits Images	Take the photo in a well-lit area. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. Upload a second photo showing the circuit board and soldering. Upload a copy of the schematics.
Electric IV & Up <i>State Static Projects</i>	Notebook	The entire notebook or presentation is to be included in a single electronic file using PDF, Word, Power Point, or Excel format.

The plexiglass covering will likely need removed to eliminate glare. Be sure the entire poster or collection box is visible in the photo. One, two or three photos will be uploaded based on grade level exhibit requirements.
Fashion Revue Consumer Clothing & Sewing Grades 3-7 <i>County Only Static Projects</i>	Video, Narrative, Optional Photo	Modeling tips are available on the 4-H Sewing project page. Create a video and upload it to YouTube or another video hosting site. Recording on a phone or similar device will work. Make sure the recording area is well-lit with minimal background noises. The recording settings should be set to only visible with a link. You will provide that link when submitting entry. The Fashion Revue Narrative will be a second upload.
Fashion Revue Sewing Grades 8-12 <i>State Static Projects</i>	Video, Narrative, Optional Photo	Modeling tips are available on the 4-H Sewing project page. Create a video and upload it to YouTube or another video hosting site. Recording on a phone or similar device will work. Make sure the recording area is well-lit with minimal background noises. The recording settings should be set to only visible with a link. You will provide that link when submitting entry. The Fashion Revue Narrative will be a second upload.

Be sure the entire exhibit, showing the top and side, is visible in the photo. The entire notebook or presentation is to be included in a single electronic file using PDF, Word, Power Point, or Excel format.
Foods, Baked <i>State Static Projects</i>	Cookies Image (3 rd Grade)	Three baked cookies are to be plated; two right-side up and the third upside-down and broken in half showing the inside and bottom. Take the photo in a well-lit area. Try to reduce as many

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		shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. The recipe card will be a second upload.
Foods, Baked <i>State Static Projects</i>	Muffins Image (4 th Grade)	Three unlined muffins are to be plated; two right-side up and the third broken in half showing the inside and bottom. Take the photo in a well-lit area. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. The recipe card will be a second upload.
Foods, Baked <i>State Static Projects</i>	Cake Image (5 th Grade)	Plate the cake for display and remove one slice from the edge to the center. On a small dessert type plate place the removed slice upside down showing the bottom. Take the photo in a well-lit area of the plated cake and plated slice together in one photo. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. The recipe card will be a second upload.
Foods, Baked <i>State Static Projects</i>	No-Yeast Pretzels or No-Yeast Biscuits Image (6 th Grade)	Three baked pretzels or biscuits are to be plated; two right-side up and the third upside-down and broken in half showing the inside and bottom. Take the photo in a well-lit area. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. The recipe card will be a second upload.
Foods, Baked <i>State Static Projects</i>	Yeast Bread Sticks or Rolls Image (Grades 7-9)	Three baked bread sticks or rolls are to be plated; two right-side up and the third upside-down and broken in half showing the inside and bottom. Take the photo in a well-lit area. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. The recipe card will be a second upload.
Foods, Baked <i>State Static Projects</i>	Yeast Bread Loaf Image (Grades 7-9)	Slice the loaf of bread in half at its middle plating one half right-side up and the other half upside-down showing its middle and bottom crust. Take the photo in a well-lit area. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. The recipe card will be a second upload.
Foods, Baked <i>State Static Projects</i>	Invented Healthy Snack Image and Notebook (Grades 7-9)	Take the photo showing the entire exhibit in a well-lit area. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. The recipe card will be a second upload. A third upload will be the entire notebook or presentation is to be included in a single electronic file using PDF, Word, Power Point, or Excel format.
Foods, Baked <i>State Static Projects</i>	Fruit Pie Image (Grades 10-12)	Remove one slice of pie. On a small dessert type plate place the removed slice upside down showing the bottom crust. Take the photo in a well-lit area of the whole pie and plated slice together in one photo. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. The recipe card will be a second upload.
Foods, Baked <i>State Static Projects</i>	Low Fat-Reduced Sugar Product or Special Dietary Product Image and Notebook (Grades 10-12)	Remove a portion of the product and place it upside down on a dessert type plate showing the bottom. Take the photo showing the entire dish and plated portion in a well-lit area. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. The recipe card will be a second upload. A third upload will be the entire notebook or presentation is to be included in a single electronic file using PDF, Word, Power Point, or Excel format.

Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. The recipe card will be a second upload.</p>

Take the photo in a well-lit area. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. The recipe card will be a second upload.</p>

<p>Garden Collection <i>State Garden</i></p>	<p>3 Plate, 4 Plate or 5 Plate Images</p>	<p>Take a photo of your exhibit with at least one stem showing and all items labeled according to exhibit requirements. Take the photo in a well-lit area. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire collection is visible in the photo.</p>
<p>Genealogy <i>State Static Projects</i></p>	<p>Notebook</p>	<p>Each notebook, in its entirety, is to be included in a single electronic file using PDF, Word, Power Point, or Excel format.</p>
<p>Geology <i>State Static Projects</i></p>	<p>Poster or Display Box Image</p>	<p>Take the photo in a well-lit area. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire poster is visible in the photo.</p>

Be sure the entire poster is visible in the photo. The entire notebook or presentation is to be included in a single electronic file using PDF, Word, Power Point, or Excel format.
Home Environment <i>State Static Projects</i>	Exhibit Display Image and Notebook or Portfolio or Presentation	Take the photo in a well-lit area. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire poster or exhibit display is visible in the photo. The entire notebook or presentation is to be included in a single electronic file using PDF, Word, Power Point, or Excel format as a second file upload.

On a small dessert type plate place the removed slice upside down showing the bottom. The recipe card will be a second upload.

Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. The craft information card will be a second file upload.</p>
<p>Sewing <i>State Static Projects</i></p>	<p>Wearable Image</p>	<p>Take a photo of the front of the article showing its finished side. Take a second photo of the article turned inside out showing the article's back side, seams, hooks and zipper. Take a third photo of the zipper, hooks or fasteners (only one photo if more than one fastener). Be sure the article has been pressed and photos are taken in a well-lit area with the article laying flat, like on a bed. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire article is visible in the photo. The skills card will be uploaded as a fourth file.</p>

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<p>Sewing <i>State Static Projects</i></p>	<p>Non-Wearable Article Image</p>	<p>Take a photo of the front of the article showing its finished side. Take a second photo of the back of the article. Take a third photo of a sewn seam, the zipper, hooks or fasteners (only one photo if more than one fastener). Be sure the article has been pressed, if possible, and photos are taken in a well-lit area with the article displayed for its intended use. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire article is visible in the photo. The skills card will be uploaded as a fourth file.</p>
<p>Sewing <i>State Static Projects</i></p>	<p>Construction Technique or Sewing Machine Survey</p>	<p>The entire notebook or presentation is to be included in a single electronic file using PDF, Word, Power Point, or Excel format.</p>
