

Hello 4-H Families,

The Fair Board has secured a floor buyer for any market animals that you need to have a buyer for. This is independent of the auction. If you are in the auction, we will not assume you are flooring the animal as well, unless you let us know. You will need to complete a floor slip on Wednesday or Thursday or reach out to the fair board at lawco.fairboard@gmail.com. All requests to floor an animal MUST be submitted by 5 pm Thursday, July 16. Cattle information must be submitted ASAP to ensure there are enough trucks coming.

The prices include:

- Dairy Cattle
 - Up to 500 lbs= .90 per pound
 - 501 lb and up= .775 per pound
- Dairy Goats= \$2.50 per pound
- Meat Goats= \$3.10 per pound (boer goats need to be fat, if not there will be a deduction)
- Sheep= \$1.40 per pound
- Beef=\$.875 per pound
- Rabbits= \$1.25 per pound
- Poultry= \$3 each

The animals will need to be on the fairgrounds by 8 am on Saturday, July 18. Cattle will be checked-in and loaded at the barn. Everyone else should park in the gravel lot (where carnival is traditionally set up), and you will be called by species to the cattle barn. Cattle should go straight to cattle barn, but come in past the Cattlemen's food stand to stay out of the way of the trucks.

There is not a floor buyer for swine.
