What are some danger foods for my cat?

- Raw meat or fish:** Due to bacteria this might cause your cat to go in a coma.
- Avocados:** Because of the persin in avocados, they are poisonous to cats.
- Chocolate:** This is poisonous to your cat and can give it liver failure.
