- Willing to mentor fellow youth and others.
- Making a significant contribution to a project, program, or ongoing activity that has impacted the quality of life for others

During the Achievement Banquet, a special cash award will be made to the recipient of this award.

Each club main leader, livestock superintendent, indoor building superintendent has the opportunity to nominate one member from their membership who might qualify for such an honor. Each application will be blinded (personal identifiers removed) and sent on to the sponsor for their review and selection. The trip committee will not be involved in the selection of the award recipient. The applications will be sent directly to the sponsor.
