### **Beginner Grades 3-5:**

Exhibit one of the following:

- An item you made from recyclables.

### **Intermediate Grades 6-8:**

Exhibit one of the following:

- A poster on one of the following topics:
  1. Identify 4 different recycling codes used on plastic packages. Be sure to define the codes. Attach 3 samples of each of the 4 codes you chose and label where the samples came from.
  2. What Belongs in Our Environment?
  3. How Can We Save Our Natural Resources?
- OR**
- An item you made from recyclables.

### **Advanced Grades 9-12:**

Exhibit one of the following:

- A poster on one of the following topics:
  1. Show how you set up a home recycling center and how well it works. Include where/how you disposed of the collected wastes.
  2. Your composting experiences which lists the proper procedures for setting up, maintaining and using the compost pile.
  3. Jennings County Solid Waste Disposal
  4. hazardous waste
- OR**
- An item you made from recyclables.
