- Poster must be 22" X 28" displayed horizontally with stiff backing and covered with plastic accompanied by a nametag in the lower front right-hand corner. Note: Refer to poster requirements on pages 7-8.
- The purpose shall be visually demonstrate the 4-H Goat Project knowledge and to demonstrate to others 4-H Goat Project possibilities.

- All posters, notebooks, and display boards must include a reference list indicating where information was obtained, giving credit to the original author, to complete the 4-H member's exhibit.

This reference list should/might include web site links, people and professionals interviewed, books, magazines, etc. It is recommended this reference list be attached to the back of a poster or display board, be the last page of a notebook, or included as part of the display visible to the public. A judge is not to discredit an exhibit for the manner in which references are listed.
